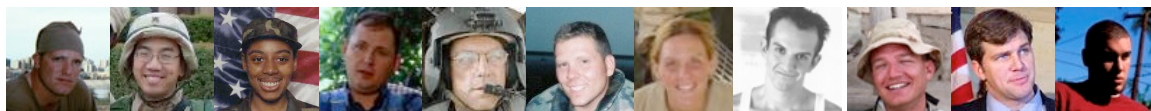
Connect With Buddies
