OPTION 3: EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

A short-term **EMERGENCY FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM** for individuals with disabilities and seniors experiencing short-term out of the ordinary financial crisis created by unforeseen emergencies that would affect independence (i.e., medication cost/medication co-pay, health aids, rent, essential utilities, etc.). The EFA Fund allows the individual to get through the emergency by working with an EOCIL Independent Living Specialist to stabilize the situation and develop a long-term plan to prevent recurrence of the crisis. Funds may be restricted donations or grants and may be available only to specific disability groups, seniors or based on eligibility conditions placed by the donor.

OPTION 5: GOODSEARCH

I commit to use GOODSEARCH for EOCIL. GoodSearch is a Web search engine (powered by Yahoo) that earns money for nonprofit organizations. EOCIL is registered with GoodSearch, so you can support EOCIL every time you search the Web (which is daily for many of us). Here's how:

- Go to ***www.goodsearch.com***
- In the middle of the page where it says, "Who do you GoodSearch for?" you type Eastern Oregon Center (don't worry the first three words will suffice), press verify, and in a moment the full name will pop up in the field: Eastern Oregon Center for Independent Living - EOCIL (Ontario, OR).
- Search from this page (why not make it your browser homepage?) or download the GoodSearch toolbar for Internet Explorer, Mozilla Firefox or Safari (Mac): ***www.goodsearch.com/toolbars.aspx***.
- Even if you download the toolbar, periodically check the GoodSearch homepage to make sure it is still set to credit EOCIL. Anytime you clean out your browser cache or cookies, you will need to re-select EOCIL as your GoodSearch beneficiary.
